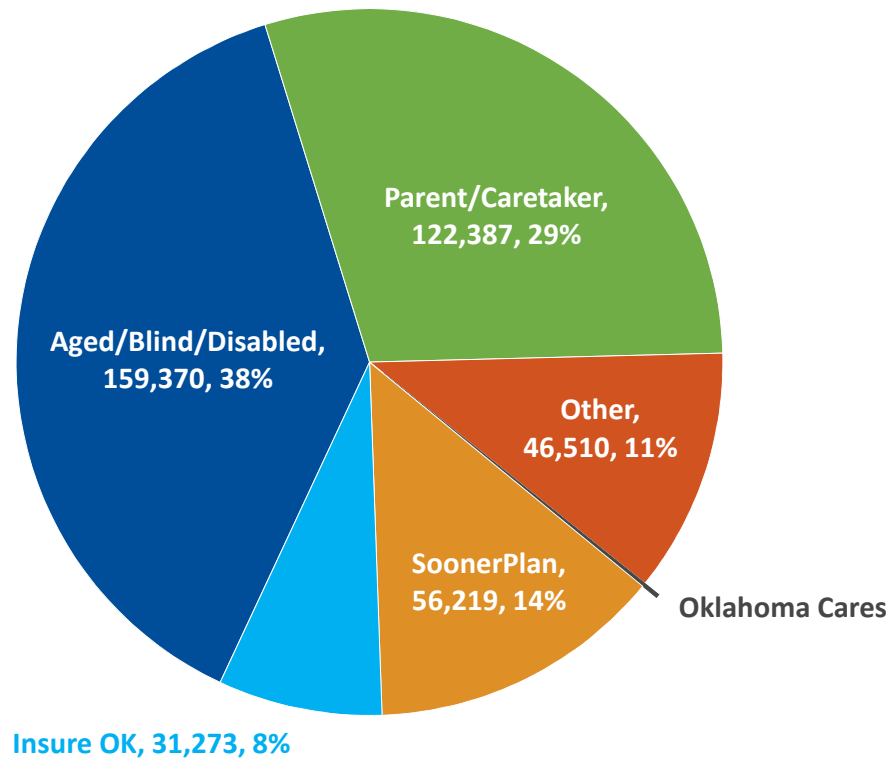


SOONERCARE POPULATIONS

during the SFY.



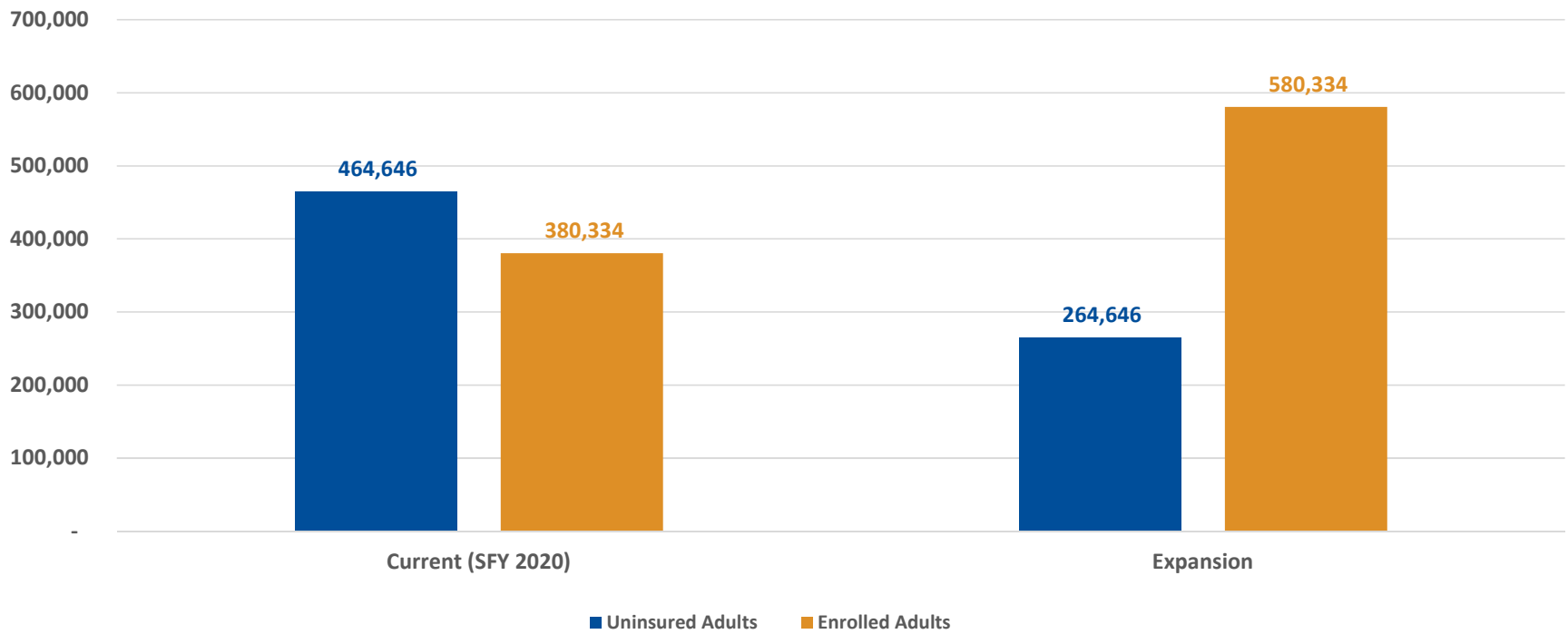

ADULT EXPANSION POPULATION

Who makes up the Adult Expansion group?

- Adults age 19-64

What are the eligibility requirements?

- FPL at or below 138%
- Citizenship/alienage
- Residence
- Cooperation with child support
- Not otherwise eligible as Parent/Caretaker Relative or Former Foster Care

When does Adult Expansion go into effect?

- July 1, 2021

Is anyone exempt from the Adult Expansion group?

- Medicare beneficiaries



SOONERCARE ADULT DENTAL BENEFITS

Medically Necessary Extractions

- Extraction of a tooth that has met medically necessary criteria due to the presence of pathology, trauma, severe periodontal involvement, significant caries, pain or infection.



PROPOSED

Proposed Adult Limited Dental Benefit Under Current Legislative Review

- Preventive – Cleanings and Fluoride
- Restorative – Fillings
- Prosthetic – Dentures

Currently at least 30 states offer a similar plan. Budget is limiting factor.

DENTAL BENEFITS FOR ADULTS

- **Maintain and preserve dental work received by SoonerCare members as children and adolescents, while also preventing future disease.**
- **Prevent more severe disease, which often results in unwarranted dental pain and tooth loss.**
- **Prevent pain and suffering that currently cannot be treated until a tooth needs extraction.**
- **Reduction of emergency department visits.**
- **Reduced need for opioid use, which may lead to addiction.**
- **Improve the ability of a person to work and provide for their family.**
- **Improvement of chronic conditions associated with oral disease.**
- **Parents who receive regular preventive dental care are more likely to bring their children in for regular preventive dental care.**
